- 1. Prosecco Corte Alta Italy** £22.95  
**125ml Glass** £5.95  
 Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries plenty of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.
- 2. J de Telmont Grande Réserve Champagne** £39.95  
 One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent nonvintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style.
- 3. Dom Perignon Champagne** £198.00  
 Utterly delicious and complex. A classic accompaniment to any stylish celebration.

## White Wine

- 4. Five Foot Track Chardonnay Australia** £17.95  
**175ml Glass** £4.95  
 A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate served up with a rounded and buttery feel. Bronze - Imbibe Sommelier Awards 2015
- 5. La Tierra Rocosa Sauvignon Blanc Chile** £19.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.50  
 Fresh lime and lemon on the nose; more citrus on the palate accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple and mouthwatering acidity.
- 6. Malandrino Pinot Grigio Italy** £19.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.50  
 Hints of perfume, pears, stone fruit and lime plus the occasional floral note. Fresh and vibrant acidity results in a light, easy drinking wine.
- 7. Quinta de Azevedo, Vinho Verde Portugal** £19.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.50  
 A little lower in alcohol than average, this lively wine has hints of spritz and bubble and complex aromas of tropical fruits. Great with Asian food.
- 8. Chablis Jacques Decharmes Burgundy, France** £29.95  
**175ml Glass** £6.95  
 Steely and minerally with aromas with citrus fruit and limestone and a crisp, fresh and vibrant palate of stony fruits, limestone, grapefruit and lemons, finishing on a racy and uplifting citrus kick.
- 9. Sancerre 'Les Romains', Domaine Vacheron Loire Valley, France** £59.95  
 This is about as intense and powerful as Sauvignon gets. Notes of white peach and minerals, fantastic purity, balance and length with hints of spice imparted by oak.
- 10. Meursault Narvaux, Louis Jadot Burgundy, France** £86.95  
 Les Narvaux is a vineyard next to Genevrières and Poruzots where grapes were all handpicked ensuring the berries remained intact until arrival at the winery. This wine exhibits the typical Meursault roundness and approachability, with a pleasing crispness and nutty accents.

## Rosé Wine

- 11. Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé Italy** £19.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.50  
 This wine shows why Rosé is so popular. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes and a refreshing zing on the palate.
- 12. Côtes de Provence Sainte Victoire, Famille Negrel South of France** £24.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.95  
 Typical of the fresh but warm Provence style; refined and complex on the nose with summer fruit and floral notes. Dry and crisp, with a delicate flavour and full texture.

## Red Wine

- 13. Fonte Do Nico Vinho Tinto Portugal** £17.95  
**175ml Glass** £4.95  
 With aromas of fresh berries, this wine is soft in the mouth with good quality tannin structure and a easy drinking finish.
- 14. Two Ridge Trail Merlot Australia** £19.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.50  
 A nose of plum and eucalyptus leads into a palate of blackberry and raspberry with a supple texture and a satisfying fruit sweetness. Gold - Imbibe Sommelier Awards 2014
- 15. Capilla de Barro Malbec Argentina** £19.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.50  
 An intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit held together by lush tannins. Bronze - Imbibe Sommelier Awards 2015
- 16. Côtes du Rhône, Remy Ferbras Rhône Valley, France** £19.95  
**175ml Glass** £5.50  
 Showing gorgeous, succulent notes of red and black berry fruit flavours and a warming hint of spiciness. Soft and supple tannins contribute to a long and rounded finish.
- 17. Rioja Reserva, Viña Eguía Spain** £29.95  
**175ml Glass** £6.95  
 The bouquet is an intense mix of dark fruit, toasted oak and clove aromas. The palate has weight yet an elegant profile.
- 18. La Réserve de Léoville-Barton, St-Julien Bordeaux, France** £59.95  
 With a classic 'left bank' nose of smoky blackberry fruit and pencil lead, the palate is rich and rounded with assertive tannins, ample fruit and well integrated oak.
- 19. Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir Marlborough, New Zealand** £69.95  
 Delicate confection nose with vanilla and hints of spice. A seductive palate, where dark cherries and strawberries are complemented by toasty characters and silky tannins. A complex and textured finish.
- 20. Château d'Armailhac 2010, Pauillac Bordeaux, France** £89.95  
 "The d'Armailhac 2010 has an intense bouquet with blackberry and briary aromas leaping from the glass, quickly followed by cedar and tobacco scents, later something more exotic like creme de cassis." Neal Martin - The Wine Advocate
- 21. Château La Gaffelière 2000, St-Emilion Bordeaux, France** £140.00  
 "This elegant, fully mature 2000 St.-Emilion reveals notes of roasted herbs, sandy, loamy soil, black currants, cassis, and a hint of incense. Mediumbodied and pure with outstanding harmony and freshness, it should last for another decade or more". Drink 2010 - 2020. 91 points. Robert Parker
