## White Wine

**La Tierra Rocosa Sauvignon Blanc. Chile** £21.95  
175ml Glass £6.50  
Fresh lime and lemon on the nose; more citrus on the palate accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple and mouthwatering acidity.

**Sancerre Blanc Duc Armand. France** £49.95  
Elegant dry white wine, pale yellow colour, aromas of white flowers and green apple and refreshing citrus flavours.

**Crescendo Pinot Grigio. Italy** £21.95  
175ml Glass £6.50  
A clean, fresh and fruity wine with lots of citrus and ripe pear flavours. Dry and crisp with refreshing finish.

**Varzea Vinho Verde. Portugal** £23.95  
175ml Glass £6.95  
A little lower in alcohol than average, this lively wine has hints of spritz and bubble and complex aromas of tropical fruits. Great with Asian food.

**Five Foot Track Chardonnay. Australia** £23.95  
175ml Glass £6.95  
A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate served up with a rounded and buttery feel.

**Chablis Elodie Duprés. France** £32.95  
175ml Glass £8.95  
Crisp and elegant, pumping with refined flavours of luscious apple and citrus fruit.

**Claro Reserva Riesling, Chile** £28.95  
A young, bright and clean wine with notes reminiscent of white flowers, white peaches and grapefruit.

**Chateau de Santenay, Saint Aubin, White Burgundy 2017 Burgundy, France** £55.95  
Although it's tucked between the two prestigious 'Montrachet' villages of Chassagne and Puligny, you can still find great value in Saint-Aubin. And it has its own fantastic reputation for fine, steely Chardonnay. This is made on a small 4-hectare vineyard there. It has notes of apricot, citrus and vanilla.

## Rosé Wine

**Bel Canto Pinot Grigio Rosé. Italy** £21.95  
175ml Glass £6.50  
This wine shows why Rosé is so popular. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes and a refreshing zing on the palate.

**Chateau Hippolyte Provence Rosé France** £29.95  
Typical of the fresh but warm Provence style; refined and complex on the nose with summer fruit and floral notes. Dry and crisp, with a delicate flavour and full texture.

## Red Wine

**Viña Carrasco Merlot. Chile** £23.95  
Offers good concentration and depth of fruit, with a soft and plummy texture, and hints of vanilla.

**Côtes du Rhône, Remy Ferbras. Rhône Valley, France** £21.95  
Showing gorgeous, succulent notes of red and black berry fruit flavours and a warming hint of spiciness. Soft and supple tannins contribute to a long and rounded finish.

**Conde de Castile Reserva, Rioja. Spain** £31.95  
175ml Glass £7.50  
A complex wine that displays a harmonious blend of dried spice, dark fruits and nuances of vanilla and tobacco.

**La Réserve de Léoville-Barton, St-Julien. Bordeaux, France** £59.95  
With a classic 'left bank' nose of smoky blackberry fruit and pencil lead, the palate is rich and rounded with assertive tannins, ample fruit and well integrated oak.

**Fonte Do Nico Vinho Tinto. Portugal** £19.95  
175ml Glass £5.95  
With aromas of fresh berries, this wine is soft in the mouth with good quality tannin structure and a easy drinking finish. Imbibe Sommelier Awards 2017

**Roaring Meg Pinot Noir, Mt Difficulty, Central Otago. New Zealand** £49.95  
This wine exhibits a lovely mix of red and black berry fruits with further complexity gained from oak spice. These characters are balanced by soft tannins, balanced acidity and a fruit-driven finish.

**Capilla de Barro Malbec. Argentina** £24.95  
175ml Glass £6.95  
An intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit held together by lush tannins.

**Duluc de Branaire Ducru, St Julien, Bordeaux 2014 Bordeaux, France** £64.95  
This is the second wine of Château Branaire-Ducru. But it's no second best. It's made from grapes hand-picked from 35-year-old vines and has an excellent length. Expect notes of ripe red fruits and sweet spice, a supple palate and fine-grained tannins.

**Château Meyney, Saint-Estèphe, Bordeaux 2013 Bordeaux, France** £69.95  
Château Meyney's grand vin is made up predominantly of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, with a dash of Petit Verdot. Its notes of blackberry, raspberry, graphite and sweet spices are framed by snappy tannins, and it's just hitting its prime now.

## Champagne & Sparkling Wine

**Nicolas Courtin N/V, Champagne** £42.95  
It's biscuity, it's citrusy - it's packed with those ripe apple flavours which speak of grapes selected with care and attention.

**Dom Perignon. Champagne** £238.00  
Utterly delicious and complex. A classic accompaniment to any stylish celebration.

**Prosecco Bel Canto. Italy** £24.95  
125ml Glass £6.50  
Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear and an elegant zest.

**Bollinger Special Cuvée NV. Champagne** £69.95  
Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent.
